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## THE DEPARTMENT OF DISTANCE EDUCATION

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### UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

This department coordinates three External degrees: The Bachelor of Education, Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Commerce degree Programmes. The Department also runs short courses in writing and publication.

### Duration of Programmes

The minimum period for completion of Bachelor of Education, Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Commerce External Degree courses is four years. The maximum is seven years. The duration for short courses varies but normally lasts 3 to 6 months.

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## THE BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (EXTERNAL)

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### Choice of Courses

Courses of study shall be selected from the following:

- a) **Compulsory Education Disciplines**  
All students registered for the B.Ed. degree programme take the following professional courses which include:
  - i) **Foundations of Education**  
This encompasses: History of Education, Philosophy of Education, Sociology of Education, Com-

parative Education, Economics of Education, Educational Administration and Planning.

- ii) **Educational Psychology**  
This encompasses: General Psychology, Human Growth and Development, Human Learning, Theories of Learning, Guidance and Counselling, Measurement and Evaluation, Research Methods.

**iii) Curriculum Studies**

This encompasses: Curriculum Theory and Evaluation, General Methods of Teaching, Education Technology and Communication.

**(iv) Development Studies**

This encompasses: Issues in Development, Science and Technology, Health and Development, Industrialization in Developing Countries, Political Economy of Education.

**(v) Research Paper**

Each student shall be required to present a supervised research paper on an approved topic. The study of methods of research, conducting research and the preparation of research report is carried out throughout the three years of the course.

**b) Elective Teaching Disciplines**

Subject to certain combination limitations, each student shall study:

**EITHER**

(a) Two disciplines selected from any one of the following subject areas:

**i) Arts and Social Sciences**

- African Languages: Kiswahili, Lwo, Luganda, Runyakitara
- Foreign Languages: English, French, German
- Others: Religious Studies, Language Education, Geography, History, Social Studies, Economics, Music.

**ii) Science**

Geography, Biology, Chemistry, Mathematics (Minor), Physics

**iii) Educational Practices and Intervention**

Educational Foundations, Education Evaluation and Supervision, Special Education, Early Childhood Education, Education Administration and Management

**OR:**

(b) One of the following specially combined subjects:

- Literature with English Language Studies
  - Literature with French language
  - French Language as a double main
  - Mathematics as a double main
- (c) One subject from the following vocational studies
- Business Education
  - Agriculture
