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## THE DEPARTMENT OF DISTANCE EDUCATION

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### UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES

This department coordinates three External degrees: The Bachelor of Education, Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Commerce degree Programmes. The Department also runs short courses in writing and publication.

### Duration of Programmes

The minimum period for completion of Bachelor of Education, Bachelor of Science and Bachelor of Commerce External Degree courses is four years. The maximum is seven years. The duration for short courses varies but normally lasts 3 to 6 months.

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## THE BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (EXTERNAL)

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### Choice of Courses

Courses of study shall be selected from the following:

- a) **Compulsory Education Disciplines**  
All students registered for the B.Ed. degree programme take the following professional courses which include:
  - i) **Foundations of Education**  
This encompasses: History of Education, Philosophy of Education, Sociology of Education, Com-

parative Education, Economics of Education, Educational Administration and Planning.

- ii) **Educational Psychology**  
This encompasses: General Psychology, Human Growth and Development, Human Learning, Theories of Learning, Guidance and Counselling, Measurement and Evaluation, Research Methods.
