

## MASTER OF ARTS IN SOCIAL AND MANAGEMENT STUDIES

### Introduction

The Master of Arts in Social and Management Studies started in 2002/2003 with the purpose of meeting better the needs of a fast changing Ugandan society.

### Objectives of the Programme

The general objective is to train leaders and administrators in order to meet the challenges of a fast developing society.

It is also intended to enable the student acquire the skills of research, management and social development.

### Regulations

The general regulations and statutes governing postgraduate programmes of Makerere University shall apply.

### Curriculum

#### Duration

The programme shall be conducted over a period of two academic years. The first year shall be 17 weeks long: 15 weeks of teaching and 2 weeks for examinations. The second year shall be for dissertation.

#### Structure

**Course Layout:** A candidate is to do five (5) courses, four (4) Core and one (1) Elective in each semester of the first year.

The programme is inter-disciplinary and encompasses courses, which are offered at Makerere University in different Schools, Faculties and Institutions of the University.

### Year II

#### Dissertation

In the second year of study, a student is expected to achieve specialization in a chosen area by research and submission of dissertation. Before embarking on research, the student must have submitted a research proposal, approved by the Academic Board of the Affiliated Institutes.

The dissertation will be examined in accordance with University regulations in force, which will determine a candidate's award or non-award of the MA (Social and Management Studies) degree.

The thesis will be examined according to the common regulation for Masters Degree in all Faculties.

#### Examination Regulations

- The General Regulations for the Masters Degree in the Faculty of Arts shall be applicable.

## POSTGRADUATE DIPLOMA IN THEOLOGY AND PASTORAL STUDIES (PGD TPS)

### Objectives of the Programme

The general objective is to train pastors and administrators.

The programme is also intended to enable the student acquire the skills of research in Theology and management of religious organizations and institutions. It will also

train the students to be agents of change in communities.

### Curriculum

#### Duration

The programme is expected to extend over one year of two semesters. Every semester shall be 17 weeks long: 15 weeks of teaching

and two weeks for examinations. In addition students are expected to do a research project to be completed during the recess term of the second semester. Students who come in without a background of Research Methodology will be given a remedial course in Research Methods.
