### **Procedural Information about Research Fund Requisition, Allocation and Accountability**

Makerere University attaches great importance to research. It regards it as a second most important mandate of the University despite its low funding. For knowledge generation, the university receives from Uganda government and other collaborating funders, research grants for members of staff to carry out research.

The Board of Postgraduate Studies and Research which is a Senate Committee takes care of the administration of research at Makerere University. The Board operates under the following terms of references as far as research is concerned.

- (1) Encourage research and other original works by members of the university.
- (2) Administer grants and grant-in-aid of publication made from university funds for these purposes.
- (3) Furnish an annual report to Senate on the administration of such grants.
- (4) The Academic Registrar is the Secretary to the Board.

**Source of funds:** Uganda Government; 1% University Income from Private students' fees; contribution by postgraduate students; bilateral funds from donors such as Sida/SAREC, Carneigie Corporation, etc.
